RESOLUTION NO. <u>15-520</u>

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING MOBILE VENDING RULES AND REGULATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF GENTRY, ARKANSAS AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Gentry, Arkansas desires to establish certain Rules and Regulations governing Mobile Vending within the City of Gentry, Arkansas.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council for the City of Gentry:

Section 1. That the City Council of the City of Gentry, Arkansas hereby adopts the following rules and regulations governing Mobile Vending within the City of Gentry, Arkansas (Section References are to the City's Mobile Vending Ordinance):

- 1. No outside storage (boxes, coke containers, bottles etc.).
- 2. Vendor may not provide outside customer seating for Limited Permit for Non-Event Operations on Public Property (See Mobile Vending Ord. Section 3.)
- 3. Vendor is to provide trash receptacles for customer use including lids with swinging doors.
- 4. Hours of Operation:
 - Section 2 Vendor: to coincide with event hours
 - o Section 3 Vendor: 6:00am-9:00pm
 - o Section 4 Vendor: Open hours of Operation
 - o Residential Auction: 8:00am- 8:00pm.
- 5. Water and refuse are to be properly disposed of, no draining of gray water on the ground and public trash receptacles are not to be used for garbage disposal.
- 6. Section 3 and 4 vendors are not allowed to connect and use public utilities.
- 7. A valid Arkansas State Board of Health permit to operate a Retail Food Establishment on display.
- 8. Privilege Licenses fees are not required if a mobile food vendor permit has been purchased.
- 9. Auctions being held in a residential zone may have 1 mobile vending permit per auction and address per year and the permit is good for 3 days only. There will be a cap of 10 auction permits allowed in any calendar year, which will be issued on a first come first serve basis.
- 10. Mobile Vending calendar and permit totals will be maintained at City Hall.
- 11. Vendors must have a current tax identification number and report all taxes to the proper regulating authorities.
- 12. If the Police Department or Fire Marshall deems a situation to be unsafe or a public nuisance the establishment may be closed immediately with no refund of fees allowed.
