AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF GENTRY TO EXECUTE A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH H & E EQUIPMENT SERVICES FOR A 2013 HAMM 3205 SMOOTH DRUM ROLLER; WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the City of Gentry that it is desirable to enter into a contract with H & E Equipment Services ("HEES") for the purchase of a 2013 Hamm 3205 Smooth Drum Roller, SN H1880377 (the "Roller"), in accordance with the Quotation attached hereto (the "Contract"); and

WHEREAS, the City is in immediate need to accept the Contract due to construction needs and the availability of this particular used machine to meet the City's requirements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GENTRY, ARKANSAS:

- 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor of the City of Gentry to enter into a contract with HEES for the purchase of the Roller in accordance with the Quotation attached as Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein (including the 1 year/1500 hour Full Machine Warranty for an additional cost of \$1,789.88), and to otherwise execute such documents as may be reasonably required in order to complete the purchase of the Roller as provided in the Contract.
- 2. The City Council of the City of Gentry, Arkansas finds that exceptional circumstances exist in connection with the proposed Contract, including the fact that the Roller is a used machine, such that the competitive bidding procedure outlined by Ark. Code Annot. §14-58-303 is deemed not feasible or practical, and it is in the best interests of the citizens and residents of the City of Gentry, Arkansas to forego such competitive bidding procedures.
- Section 3. Emergency. Given the ongoing needs and requirements related to ongoing City work, the Council finds that this Ordinance being necessary for the immediate protection of
